

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **Legal Liability** - Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible neither the Organisers of this event nor the Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
2. **Health and Safety** – the Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organiser and all Officials and Stewards.
3. **Safety Rules** - Failure to comply with safety rules will result in elimination
4. **Photography**- By entry to this competition competitors agree to being photographed by the Official Photographer
5. **Hats**: Must conform to Pony Club regulations and MUST be tagged with official Pony Club tag (Tags will be available at the venue) - PAS015:1998, EN 1384:1996 or BSEN 1384:1997 with BSI Kitemark, Snell E2001, AS/NZS 3838 1998 or AS/NZS 3838 2003. Hats must be worn with chinstrap fastened at all times when mounted. Skull caps with removable covers are COMPULSORY for Classes 11 – 14) and are recommended for all Classes
6. **Dress**: Jackets, plain navy or black sweaters **with long sleeves** or Pony Club Sweatshirts may be worn. **NO CROSS COUNTRY COLOURS.**
7. **Body Protector**: An effective BETA standard body protector must be worn. Body Protectors that require a key to remove them must be declared & a spare key, in a prenamed sealed envelope, left with the secretary prior to competing and collected once the competitor has finished.
8. **Medical Armband** must be worn (Medical Armbands on sale at event)
9. **Insurance**: Non Pony Club Members should ensure that they have valid insurance to cover both themselves and their mounts
10. The organisers reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any class and reserve the right to disqualify anyone for the misuse of whip or spurs (Pony Club members must carry current permission from their DC), dangerous riding or any horse in poor or lame condition. and to refuse any entry for any reason and at their sole discretion.
11. The Judges decisions are final. Objections may only be made by owners or riders and must be submitted to the Secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the final scores being posted on completion of the class, accompanied by a deposit of £20. The deposit only to be repayable if an objection is upheld.
12. **No pony may be ridden by more than one competitor in any one class.** Competitors may enter more than one pony in each class but, should the entries exceed those that can be managed in any one class, the withdrawal of the extra entry may be requested and the entry fee refunded.
13. **No horse/pony may go round Cross Country courses more than twice.**
14. Three refusals at any one fence or a total of four refusals will eliminate the competitor. **Eliminated competitors in Classes 11-14 must leave the course**
15. **No watches to be worn on the XC course**
