

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **Legal Liability** - Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible neither the Organisers of this event nor the Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
2. **Health and Safety** – the Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organiser and all Officials and Stewards.
3. **Safety Rules** - Failure to comply with safety rules will result in elimination
4. **Photography**- By entry to this competition competitors agree to being photographed by the Official Photographer
5. The organisers reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any class and to refuse any entry for any reason and at their sole discretion.
6. The Judges decisions are final
7. Objections may only be made by Owners or Riders and must be submitted to the Secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the completion of the class, accompanied by a deposit of £10
8. Hats of all competitors must comply with Pony Club standards and be marked with a Pony Club tag. They must be worn with chin strap fastened at all times when mounted, with plain black or dark blue covers only. A competitor whose hat comes off his/her head whilst riding in a competition must, on penalty of elimination, replace it before continuing.
9. An effective BETA standard body protector and a completed Medical Armband must be worn (Medical Armbands on sale at event). Long sleeves are compulsory for the Cross Country phase
10. The Event is run under Pony Club Eventing Rules 2008
11. Competitors may ride two ponies, entries permitting but no horse/pony may be ridden by more than one competitor.

ALL CLASSES

Combination not to have competed in a Senior Pony Club One Day Event Age as at 1 January 2008

CLASS 1 13 Years and Over Level 2

Pony Club Eventing Test 2005 to be ridden.
(Jumps Max. height 75 cm)

CLASS 2 12 Years and Under Level 2

Pony Club Introductory Dressage Test 2007 to be ridden.
(Jumps Max. Height 75 cm).

CLASS 3 10 Years and Under Level 1

Pony Club Introductory Dressage Test 2007 to be ridden.
(Jumps Max height 60 cm)

Dressage tests for Classes 1 – 3 may **not** be called.

Tack must comply with the Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2008 and will be inspected prior to Dressage and Cross Country

Teams of 4 Riders from **Class 2 & 3** – best three to count from either Class. Teams must be declared before the start of Class 2

CLASS 4 8 Years and Under - COMBINED TRAINING

(Dressage & Show Jumping only).
Pony Club D Level 1 Dressage Test to be ridden.
Jumps 45cm approximately

The Dressage Test may be called with no penalties.
No tack restriction
Members may be accompanied, not led, for the addition of 20 penalties in the Show Jumping phase

Competitors who enter Class 4 may NOT enter Classes 2 or 3

Rosettes to 6th place and all who complete without elimination in Classes 3 and 4.

Traherne Challenge Cup – Class 1

Wilkinson Challenge Trophy /Junior Committee Trophy – Class 2

Wallwin Trophy/Pike Cup – Class 3

Carter Cup – Class 4

Fitzwilliam (Milton) Cup – Team from Classes 2 & 3

Horse & Pony Shield – Youngest competitor in Classes 2 & 3 to compete all three phases without elimination

Fitzwilliam Challenge Cup – Best Fitzwilliam Member Dressage Score in Classes 2 and 3 (must have completed all three phases without elimination)

Class 4 : £10.00 per entry
Team : £8.00 per Team
