

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **Legal Liability** - Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible neither the Organisers of this event nor the Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
2. **Health and Safety** – the Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organiser and all Officials and Stewards.
3. **Safety Rules** - Failure to comply with safety rules will result in elimination
4. **Photography**- By entry to this competition competitors agree to being photographed by the Official Photographer
5. The organisers reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any class and to refuse any entry for any reason and at their sole discretion.
6. The Judges decisions are final
7. Objections may only be made by owners or riders and must be submitted to the Secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the completion of the class, accompanied by a deposit of £10
8. Non-Pony Club Members must ensure that they are adequately insured to take part in the competition.
9. **Hats of all competitors whether Pony Club members or not must be tagged with a Pony Club tag to confirm that it complies with the following standard.** It must bear the CE Mark AND a quality symbol: PAS 015:1998 or EN 1384:1996 or BS EN 1384:1997 (with the BSI Kitemark); Snell E2001 with the official Snell label and number; SAI Global AS/NZS 3838 1998 or AS/NZS 3838 2003. **A hat with a fixed peak is NOT allowed to be worn on the Cross Country section of the competition** Hats must be worn with chin strap fastened at all times when mounted, with plain black or dark blue covers only. A competitor whose hat comes off his/her head whilst riding in a competition must, on penalty of elimination, replace it before continuing.
10. An effective BETA standard body protector and a completed Medical Armband must be worn (Medical Armbands on sale at event)
11. No horse/pony may be ridden by more than one competitor
12. The Event is run under the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2008, except where otherwise stated. Outside assistance will result in disqualification (*Rule 28m*).
13. Competitors must be correctly dressed as if to ride when receiving awards at the prize giving.
14. No dogs allowed except on lead.
