## **Rules & Regulations**

1. The organisers shall not be held liable for any claim in respect of theft, damage or accident to any person, animal or vehicle.
2. No dogs are permitted on the show ground unless on a lead.
3. The judges' decisions are final. Objections can be made in writing with the objector's full name and address and must be lodged at the Secretary's office within an hour of the event taking place, together with a £10 deposit. The deposit shall be returned if the objection is sustained.
4. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and to alter or cancel a class if necessary.
5. Anyone riding a horse/pony at this show must wear a hard hat and those competing in any S.J. XC. or Working Hunter class must wear an approved BSI Standard or European Standard jockey skull-cap in the jumping phase. Anyone entering the clear round cross-country must wear an approved back protector.
6. The committee reserve the right to amalgamate & reduce the prize money if there is a lack of entries in any classes.
7. No lungeing or exercising is permitted in the Lorry Park or Public Areas. Horses or ponies must not be ridden faster than a trot outside any ring.
8. Trophies may be collected from the Secretary on production of the Trophy Card and must be signed for by an adult. Trophies must be returned in a clean and undamaged state. It is the responsibility of the winner to insure the trophy whilst it is in his/her possession.
9. Horses and Ponies may only be tied to their vehicle for tacking-up or un-tacking purposes and must not be left unattended.
10. Drivers must park their Vehicles as directed by the Stewards.
11. **Photography.** By entering Classes competitors agree to being photographed by the Official Photographer.
12. **There will be an additional, one-off £2 charge for every rider to cover First Aid costs.**

### **UNAFFILIATED WORKING HUNTER**

Judged under Working Hunter Rules

All classes suitable for novice riders and horses.

*Entries on the day - £8 per class*

*Prizes £8, £5, £3*

### ***HORSES***

- Class 8      **Novice Working Hunter**  
Open to horses 4yrs or over, exceeding 14.2hh (148cm). Rider any age.  
No fence will exceed 2'6" (75cm)
- Class 9      **Open Working Hunter**  
Open to horses 4yrs or over, exceeding 14.2hh (148cm). Rider any age.  
No fence will exceed 3' (90cm)
- Class 10     **Working Hunter Championship**  
For 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 8 & 9. The champion will receive a challenge cup.

### ***PONIES - Not to start before 1pm***

- Class 11     **Novice Working Hunter Pony**  
Mare or Gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 14.2hh (148cm). Rider not to have attained 14th birthday. No Fence to exceed 1'9" (55cm)
- Class 12     **Open Working Hunter Pony**  
Mare or Gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 14.2hh (148cm), rider any age. No Fence to exceed 2'6" (75cm)
- Class 13     **Working Hunter Pony Championship**  
For 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 11-12. The champion will receive a challenge trophy.

*A special rosette will be awarded in classes 8,9,11 & 12 to the highest placed member of the Fitzwilliam Hunt.*

### **UNAFFILIATED SHOW JUMPING – PONIES**

14.2hh (148cms) & under

*Entries on the day - £6 per class*

*Prizes £8, £5, £3*

- Class 1          Nursery Novice – (Approx. 1'6"/45cm). Not to have been placed in any jumping competition. Competitors may be led in this class.
- Class 2          Novice – Pony and rider combination not to have won a show jumping competition. (Approx. 1'9"/55cm)
- Class 3          Intermediate – (Approx. 2'3"/70cm)
- Class 4          Open – (Approx. 2'9"/85cm)

### **UNAFFILIATED SHOW JUMPING – HORSES**

Over 14.2hh (148cm)

*Entries on the day - £6 per class*

*Prizes £8, £5, £3*

- Class 5          Novice – Combination of horse and rider, not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> in any show jumping competition. (Approx. 2'3" / 70cm)
- Class 6          Intermediate – (Approx. 2'6"/75cm)
- Class 7          Open – (Approx. 2'9"/85cm)

Sheets to be collected 45 minutes after close of class. Test sheets will be forwarded if required on presentation of an s.a.e. Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place.

If riding in other classes, PLEASE indicate on entry form to assist with timings where possible. Please note that classes may still clash.

If you wish to withdraw please inform the Dressage Secretary ASAP to reduce any waiting list. Refunds will only be given with a veterinary or doctors certificate presented within 1 week of the event, less administration fee £1.50.
