



- (a) A bet on a horse withdrawn before it comes under Starter's Orders, will be refunded.
- (b) If a horse is withdrawn late, Tattersalls Committee has authorised the following deductions under Rule 4(c) from winnings, based on the price on the withdrawn horse to compensate bookmakers who are obliged to return stakes on the withdrawn horse, as they would have laid shorter odds about the other runners when compiling their book.


