Rules & Regulations

1. The organiser's shall not be held liable for any claim in respect of theft, damage or accident to any person, animal or vehicle.
2. Dogs are permitted but must be kept on a lead.
3. The judges' decisions are final. Objections can be made in writing with the objector's full name and address and must be lodged at the Secretary's office within an hour of the event taking place, together with a £10 deposit. The deposit shall be returned if the objection is sustained.
4. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and to alter or cancel a class if necessary.
5. Anyone riding a horse/pony at this show must wear a hard hat and those competing in any S.J. or Eventer Trial class must wear an approved BSI Standard or European Standard jockey skull-cap in the jumping phase.
6. Horses or ponies must not be ridden faster than a trot outside any ring.
7. Trophies must be signed for by an adult at the ring side. Trophies must be returned in a clean and undamaged state. It is the responsibility of the winner to insure the trophy whilst it is in his/her possession.
8. Horses and Ponies may only be tied to their vehicle for tacking-up or un-tacking purposes and must not be left unattended.
9. Drivers must park their Vehicles as directed by the Stewards.

RING 2 – 10.00am start

UNAFFILIATED ARENA EVENTING – ON GRASS

Entries on the day - £15 per class.

The classes consist of 5-8 show jumps immediately followed by 5-8 knockdown cross-country style fences. Stop watches are not permitted. The whole round will be timed. The winner will be the competitor with the lowest number of penalties. In the event of a tie, the winner will be the one closest to the optimum time.

- Class 1** 30 cm – competitors may be led.
If sufficient entries class will be split into lead rein and non-lead rein.
- Class 2** 40 cm – competitors may be accompanied
If sufficient entries class will be split into accompanied and non-accompanied
- Class 3** 50 cm
- Class 4** 60 cm
- Class 5** 70 cm
- Class 6** 80 cm
- Class 7** 90 cm

A special rosette will be awarded in all classes to the highest placed member of the Fitzwilliam Hunt.

UNAFFILIATED RIDDEN HUNTER

Judged under Ridden Hunter Rules. *Entries on the day - £12 per class*

Class 1 Novice Ridden Hunter

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over. Suitable to go trail hunting for a day. Horses not to have won first prize of £5 or over in any Ridden Hunter Class.

Class 2 Open Ridden Hunter

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over. Suitable to go trail hunting for a day.

RETIRED RACEHORSES

Thoroughbreds must have raced in Great Britain and be registered with Weatherbys. Horses to be 4yrs or over and Riders 15yrs & above.

Entries on the day - £12 per class

Class 3 Ridden Retired Racehorse.

Mare or Gelding, years or over, hold a Weatherby's Thoroughbred passport and have raced in GB or Ireland. Rider 15 years & over.

12.15pm FANCY DRESS

Open Fancy Dress Pony – Entry fee £5, prizes in kind

Class 4 BEST TURNED OUT HORSE/PONY

To be ridden or in hand. Class will be split if sufficient numbers. Entry fee £5, rosettes.

Class 6 BONNIEST HORSE/PONY

Class will be split if sufficient number. Entry fee £5, rosettes.

Horses / Ponies over 15 years. To be ridden or in hand
